### "THE GIFT"

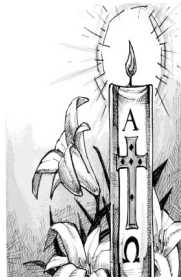

### The Solemnity of the Assumption - 15th August

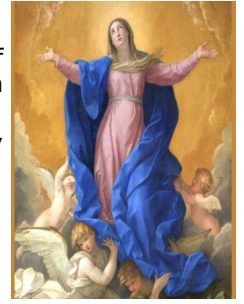
Tuesday 15th August is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and is a Holy Day of Obligation.
