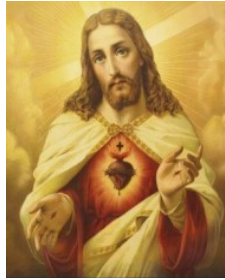
.Friday Benediction in the Month of June

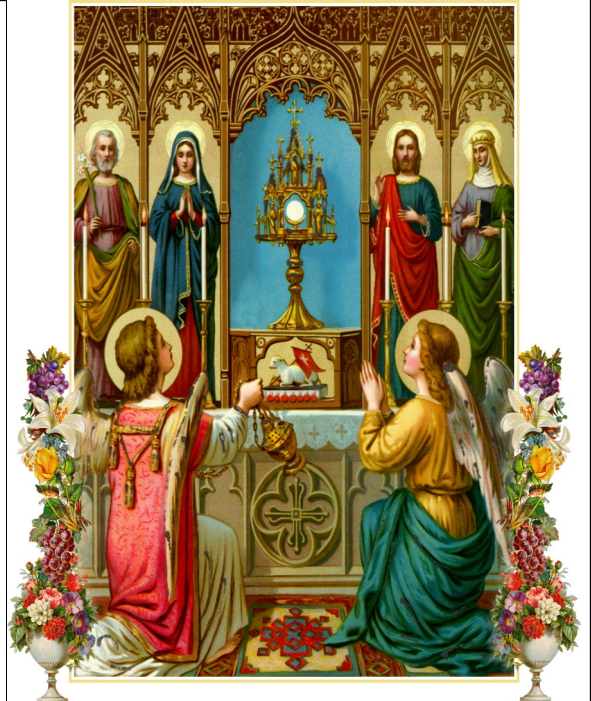

Let us pray.

O God, who under a wonderful Sacrament hast left us a memorial of Thy Passion; grant us, we beseech Thee, so to reverence the sacred mysteries of Thy Body and Blood, that we may ever feel within ourselves the fruit of Thy redemption: Thou who livest and reignest forever and ever. Amen.

The priest puts on the Humeral Veil; the people are then blessed with the Blessed Sacrament as the bell is rung thrice. All bow in adoration.

After Benediction we pray the Divine Praises repeating each praise after the priest. Then we sing together three times:

O Sacrament Most Holy, O Sacrament Divine, all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment thine.
