Bridget's Requiem Mass will be in St. Anne's on Wednesday 30th August at 9.30am. Reception the night before at 5pm.

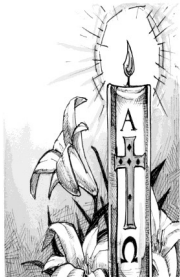
Eileen's Requiem Mass will be in Corpus Christi on Thursday 31st August at 10am. Reception the night before at 5pm.

Harvington Hall

Harvington Hall is a splendid Elizabethan House that was used to hide Priest's during the time of the Reformation. There are many priest hiding holes to see in this moated house.

There is free parking, teas and a picnic area.

Free timed tours of the Elizabethan House of Harvington Hall are available but you will have to book these on the day at the table in the courtyard.
