Weekend Appeal 29th/30th July

Next weekend Fr. James Cadman from the Diocese of Maasin in the Philippines will make an appeal on behalf of the seminarians training for the priesthood in his diocese. The seminarians are very dedicated and generous young men. On the path to fulfilling their call to the Priesthood, they are called to holiness and service to souls in a world that is in urgent need of returning to Our Lord. However, they do not always have the financial means necessary for the seven to nine years that it takes to complete the seminary program and be ordained a priest.

The expense of maintaining the seminary building, as well as that of lodging, feeding, providing instruction, and supplying the necessary study materials to approximately sixty young men, is very high. The seminarians are thus asked to contribute the relatively small amount per month toward these costs, but many are not able to afford this contribution. The second Collection that weekend will go to support the Paul VI Seminary in Maasin.
