2018, the year of two significant anniversaries for our two parishes

St. Anne's Church was opened on 14th September in 1978 and will be celebrating it's 40th Anniversary.

Corpus Christi Church was opened on 2nd October in 1958 and will be celebrating it's 60th Anniversary.

While 2018 may seem along way off, organising big events like these takes time, planning and preparation. Having two parishes, each with a big celebration in the same year will be double the planning, time and preparation. We need to start thinking now how parishioners would like to see these anniversaries celebrated?

These anniversaries would probably be celebrated with a Mass; who would we invite? Former clergy and Religious Sisters? An Archbishop? The architects? The first couple to be married or child to be baptised from the church? Who?

Does it have to be celebrated on one day or can it be over the whole year with a number of days? Could there be a joint garden party or a social evening between the two parishes, sharing each others happy occasion? Perhaps an up to date history booklet? A piece of art work to recall the event like a stone tablet or a stained glass window or doors. Corpus Christi has no parish hall, what about an extension to the Fr. Tuite Room, or a bigger porch complete with toilet? What about recovering the kneelers and adding cushions to make the pews more comfortable in St. Anne's?

These are just some thoughts to begin the process and get ideas going. If you have any thoughts or ideas please do share them. 2018 might seem a while away but it is only 344 days away and the clock is ticking.
