Gift Aid Envelopes for the New Tax Year

Members of the Parishes Finance teams will be handing out the new Gift Aid Envelopes for the New Tax Year over the next few weeks. **What is GIFT AID?** Gift Aid is a wonderful way for all charities to raise extra money without costing the person a single penny. By declaring you pay Income Tax or Tax on Pensions the Government will pay back free of charge the charity 25p for every £1 donated. Last year those 25 pence's added up to in Corpus Christi **£9,641.45** and St. Anne's **£1,349.83**. Non of that money cost a parishioner a penny, it was a gift from the Government.

THERE IS NO CATCH, THIS TRULY IS A GIFT FROM THE GOVERNMENT. SO PLEASE USE IT IF YOU CAN.

If you are able to Gift Aid and would like a set of Gift Aid envelopes then please complete a **Declaration Form** which a Finance Team Member will give you if you ask. You can also pay by Direct debit. If you don't pay Income Tax and a Family member does, then why not ask them to sign a form on your behalf.
