It would be nice to have Altar Servers as these Masses.

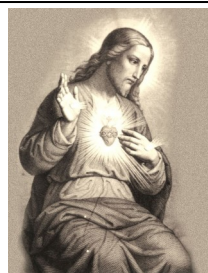

Day of Prayer for Vocations before the Blessed Sacrament

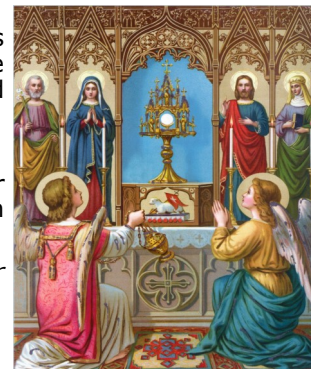

The proposed Community Centre at Corpus Christi

Having met with the Diocesan Trust and Grants Funding Officer last Thursday the outcome of that first meeting was that we are required to draw up a 'Feasibility Report' that is an assessment of the practicality of our proposed project in order to try and evaluate its potential success especially if we are to convince others of its need when applying for external funding and grants. There is a cost to writing up this report, however there are grants to cover the cost of the Feasibility Report but we will have to wait for six to eight weeks to know if we have been successful in obtaining the funding to write up the report in order to apply for funding and grants to build our desired Centre.
