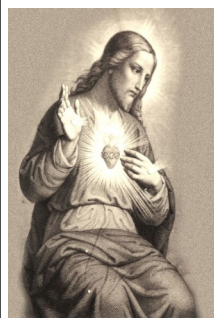

The Use of Mobile Phones in Church

A number of parishioners in both churches have noticed people reading and sending text messages during Holy Mass. The people sending these text messages and reading them are not teenagers. They are adults. Some parents and grandparents are allowing their children to play video games on their phones again, during Holy Mass?? Do these parishioners really think it appropriate to be behaving in this manner?

We come to Mass to worship Almighty God through the prayer and sacrifice of Jesus Christ his only begotten Son. Christ himself said we are to love God with all our heart, with all our soul and with all our strength. Can we really be doing this if we are texting messages on our phones or allow our children to play video games during Mass?

Are the couple at the dinner table or out walking with each other, really in each others company if they are on their phones? What is the point of being with someone if you are not with them in mind and body?

Regarding Church, the phrase, "*at least they're here*" doesn't wash not in the light of the Gospel. Buy the children a child friendly Mass book and give them a good example and witness, lead them in the prayers, and make sure they are joining in being part of the celebration. Church is something we belong to, not somewhere we go to.

If we cannot spend one hour with God, how on earth will we be able to spend an eternity with him in heaven. Switch off your phones, and engage with God.
