Walsingham is an ancient shrine of Our Lady. So much in our history points to the significance of this holy place. It was originally founded in 1061. It was destroyed in 1538. It was restored in 1896.

Pope Leo XIII said that,

"When England goes back to Walsingham, Our Lady will come back to England"

Today's shrine is in an urgent need of an upgrade especially for new facilities for the disabled and young people. The Bishops of England are asking for our help with improving the facilities at Walsingham

There are Gift Aid envelopes at the back of Church for those who pay tax.

For those who do not know the story of Walsingham:

In 1061 Our Lady appeared to Lady Richeldis de Faverches and asked her to build a replica of the Holy House of Nazareth. Thousands of pilgrims over the centuries made their way to this shrine including Kings and Queens, to seek Our Lady's Help and Intercession. England became known as Mary's Dowry. Sadly, this beautiful shrine, like so many others, was destroyed by King Henry VIII. The statue of Our Lady was taken away and burnt.
